#### 1. 235 Greenwood Road, Glenview

Garden style: Controlled wild with a touch of whimsy, but mostly manipulated by "Gump" the tortoise. If you're wondering why, stop in and ask. If you've been to this yard before, come again to see how much "Gump" has grown.

Three ponds: a turtle, koi, and goldfish pond; a frog pond; and a water feature pond. These ponds sit amidst a blend of wildflowers, perennials, groundcovers, vines, and grasses; with a splash of annuals and a few vegetables and herbs.

Take a load off your feet and relax for a few minutes under the cozy arbor Ken made.

Park on the **shoulder** of Greenwood - best on west side, or on side streets 1/4 block north or south. No parking in driveway.


