1. 235 Greenwood Road, Glenview

Esther & Ken

Three ponds: a turtle, koi, and goldfish pond; a frog pond; and a water feature pond. You can get a close up of some of the turtles. Garden style: A little wild, a little controlled, a little whimsy, a little contrived. "Gump" the tortoise manipulates a lot of what happens in our yard, hence there's a lot of gardening in pots. If you've been to this yard before, come again to see how much "Gump" has grown. No parking in driveway. Park on the **shoulder** of Greenwood - best on west side, or on side streets 1/4 block north or south.


